RECAP of Ruth 2

"As it turns out" – Ruth "coincidently" ends up gleaning in fields of a relative [BOAZ] of Naomi and thereby her deceased husband. Ruth 1:16-17 [NKJV] But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God. (17) Where you die, I will die, And there will I be buried..."

Prov 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.
